### **Abandoned Vehicles at Will Rogers World Airport Towed to Airport Lots**

Persons who abandoned vehicles at Will Rogers World Airport last Thursday and Friday should contact the airport for the location of their vehicles.

Airport authorities towed nearly 40 vehicles on Friday and Saturday so that entrance and exit roadways to the airport terminal could be cleared. The airport contracted an independent towing service to assist in getting the vehicles out of harm's way and clearing the clogged roadways.

Cars that were left on *Meridian Avenue south from 54<sup>th</sup> Street, Terminal Drive or Air Cargo Road* were moved to one of two locations: the gravel lot on the north side of Amelia Earhart Road just across from the Remote Shuttle Lot, and a second gravel lot located on the east side of Meridian across from AAR Aircraft Services.

Vehicle owners who want to claim their vehicles should contact the airport at 680-3262.

The airport moved the vehicles at no charge to the vehicle owner.
