## **DELTA TO ADD NONSTOP SERVICE TO ORLANDO, FLORIDA** *Special low fares to introduce service*

OKLAHOMA CITY – Delta Air Lines announced today that it would begin nonstop service between Oklahoma City and Orlando, Florida beginning November 2, 2005. The new route will provide service to one of Oklahoma's fastest growing destination cities.

Delta Connection carrier Atlantic Southeast Airlines (ASA) will operate the new service from Orlando using the 50-seat Bombardier CRJ200 aircraft.

To celebrate this new service, Delta is offering customers, for a limited time, a special one-way introductory fare of \$99. Customers should act quickly, though, because tickets must be purchased by Oct. 11, 2005 to obtain the special fare.

Orlando, Oklahoma City's number 13<sup>th</sup> ranked market, has nearly doubled the number of passengers traveling to and from the city in the last ten years. Like Las Vegas, Orlando has become one of the country's premier leisure destinations and the addition of nonstop service will make travel to the city much more convenient and efficient for travelers.

Oklahoma City was one of five cities in the Midwest and South that were announced today for the Orlando service. Tulsa, Dallas-Fort Worth, TX, Baton Rouge, LA and Kansas City, MO will also have the route added.

Delta and Delta Connection Carriers currently operate sixteen daily, nonstop flights from Will Rogers World Airport; four to Atlanta, four to Cincinnati, and four to Salt Lake City.
