Frontier Airlines Starts Seasonal Nonstop Service to Florida Orlando and Tampa Routes Begin this Week

OKLAHOMA CITY, January 12, 2010 – Flying to a warm, sunny place this winter just got a lot easier for Oklahoma travelers. Beginning Friday, January 15, low-fare carrier Frontier Airlines will launch seasonal nonstop service from Oklahoma City to Orlando International Airport (MCO).

Orlando is one of Oklahoma City’s most popular destination cities, ranking 11th in total number of origin and destination passengers. The Orlando service will operate four days a week, expanding to five days a week February 15.

On Sunday, January 17, Frontier will fly nonstop flights two days per week between Oklahoma City and Tampa International Airport (TPA)

“The new service provides the traveling public a convenient and affordable option to two great markets,” says airport director Mark Kranenburg. “Frontier’s decision to add these new routes shows confidence in Oklahoma City. It is an excellent addition to air service in our community.”

Frontier will operate the new service with the Embraer 190, a 99-seat regional jet. The spacious jet boasts wider seats and the popular two-by-two seating configuration, providing more passenger comfort and satisfaction.

“We are thrilled to bring the Oklahoma City community its only nonstop service to the sunshine state,” said Daniel Shurz, Frontier’s vice president of strategy and planning. “Customers jetting to or from our Florida destinations will enjoy Frontier’s great customer service and affordable fares. In addition, customers will travel in comfort on the Embraer 190 aircraft outfitted with several rows of STRETCH seating in the front of the aircraft, which provides customers an additional five inches of legroom.”

To kick off the new service, Frontier is offering a \$79 one way fare, excluding fees and taxes. Tickets must be purchased by February 12, 2010 and travel must occur by April 18, 2010
