Southwest Airlines Increases Service from Oklahoma City

WILL ROGERS WORLD AIRPORT (March 8, 2007) – Southwest Airlines announced today that the airline will initiate new, daily, non-stop roundtrip service from Will Rogers World Airport to Baltimore-Washington International Airport beginning August 4, 2007. Although exact flight times are undecided, Southwest Airline representatives have indicated the new service will offer an early morning flight to Baltimore-Washington International Airport and a return flight to Oklahoma City Will Rogers World Airport in the evening.

Airport officials have announced eight new non-stop flights between Oklahoma City and key destinations in less than six months, including Los Angeles and the Washington DC area. Will Rogers World Airport currently provides daily, non-stop flights to 19 destinations from Oklahoma City. As a result of the recent air service announcements, Will Rogers World Airport will soon provide daily, non-stop service to 25 destinations.

“The decision to increase service at Will Rogers World Airport is a clear indication that Oklahoma City is an important and valuable market for Southwest Airlines,” said Mark
