Spring Snow Storm May Cause Flight Delays Travelers Urged to Check Flight Status Before Coming to Airport

OKLAHOMA CITY, March 19, 2010 – Aircraft operations at Will Rogers World Airport may be delayed or cancelled Saturday and Sunday due to a late winter storm expected to hit the metro area beginning tonight.

At this time it is difficult to predict how many flights will be impacted until there is a better picture of the scale of the storm as it develops overnight. Snow and low visibility will most likely be the issues determining if planes will be taking off or landing.

Airport crews are standing ready and prepared to work through the night to begin treating or clearing runways immediately as snow or ice begin to accumulate.

Travelers and meeters and greeter are strongly advised to contact their airline for flight status prior to coming to the airport.
