TRANSMERIDIAN AIRLINES TAKES TO THE AIR FROM WILL ROGERS AIRPORT

LITHIA SPRINGS, GA—TransMeridian Airlines' inaugural flights from Will Rogers International Airport to both Orlando Sanford and Las Vegas are on Wednesday, February 11. Both flights are nonstop and operate twice a week with service on Wednesday and Saturday.

Airfares for the Orlando Sanford flight start at just \$89* one way, while airfares to Las Vegas start at just \$79* one way, both for travel through September 7, 2004. Tickets can be purchased at www.iflytma.com where passengers receive a five-percent discount, by calling 1-866-I FLY-TMA or contacting a professional travel agent. TransMeridian Airlines does not require an advance purchase or a Saturday night stay to obtain its low airfares. The flights will be operated with an extended range Boeing Super 727-200 aircraft offering 10 first-class seats and 154 coach seats. First-class seating on both flights is available for an additional \$50 each way and includes enhanced, complimentary meal service, larger, leather seats, as well as free cocktails.

The flight to Orlando Sanford will leave Will Rogers Airport every Wednesday and Saturday at 6:55 a.m. and arrive at 10:35 a.m. The return flight leaves Orlando Sanford the same days at 12:05 p.m., arriving in Oklahoma City at 1:55 p.m.

The flight to Las Vegas leaves Will Rogers Airport every Wednesday and Saturday at 2:55 p.m. and arrives at 3:35 p.m. The return flight leaves Las Vegas the same days at 1:30 a.m., arriving in Oklahoma City at 5:55 a.m.

"We are pleased to provide air service to the people of Oklahoma City and are confident in the success of our nonstop flights to Orlando Sanford and Las Vegas," said Rob Binns, president of TransMeridian Airlines. "We firmly believe that as more people learn about our everyday low airfares, high-end service and added amenities our flights will be consistently sold out."
