## United Airlines Begins Nonstop Service to LAX

OKLAHOMA CITY – United Airlines today launched nonstop service to Los Angeles from Will Rogers World Airport. The new service is the only scheduled nonstop flight between OKC and the City of Angels providing Oklahoma City travelers more timesaving convenience to one of its top 15 destinations.



“Nonstop service to Los Angeles has been one of the most requested routes by Oklahoma City travelers,” says airport director Mark Kranenburg. “We are glad United Airlines recognizes Los Angeles as an important destination for our community. United Express will operate the service seven days a week with the their **explus<sup>sm</sup>** service, a 70-passenger seat aircraft that offers three seating options including the amenities of United First®, the extra legroom of Economy Plus® and Economy. Each row contains only four seats with two seats on either side of the aisle, eliminating middle seats, along with providing easy access to overhead bins.

United Airlines also provides daily nonstop service from Will Rogers World Airport to Chicago and Denver. The airline has served Oklahoma City since 1981.

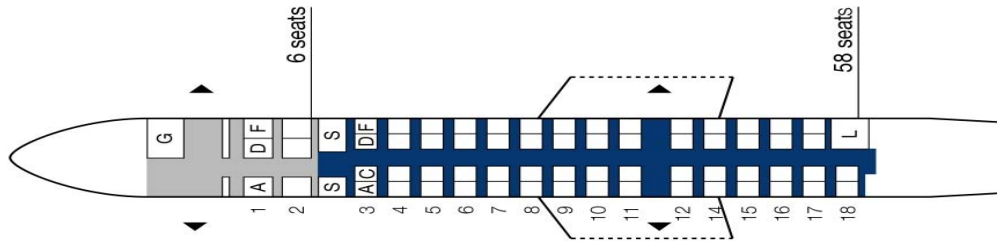
*About Will Rogers World Airport*
