Will Rogers World Airport to get Nonstop Service to Los Angeles on United Express

OKLAHOMA CITY –Will Rogers World Airport announced today they will receive nonstop service to Los Angeles from Oklahoma City starting September 6, 2006. The new service is the only scheduled nonstop flight between OKC and LAX, and will provide Oklahoma City travelers more convenience to one of its top 15 destinations.

“Securing nonstop service to Los Angeles has been high on our priority list,” says airport director Mark Kranenburg. “It is a route we feel is critical to the continued growth of the airport and Oklahoma City. We are glad United Airlines recognizes Los Angeles as an important destination for our community.”

United Express will operate the service seven days a week with the their **explussm** service, a 70-passenger seat aircraft that offers three seating options including the amenities of United First® and the extra legroom of Economy Plus®. Each row contains only four seats with two seats on either side of the aisle, eliminating middle seats, along with providing easy access to overhead bins.

Los Angeles is the third destination that United Airlines has initiated in Oklahoma City since the beginning of the year. In February, United began nonstop service to New Orleans then added nonstop service to San Antonio in March. United Airlines also provides daily nonstop service from Will Rogers World Airport to Chicago and Denver.



The airline has served Oklahoma City since 1981.
