United Airlines Begins Nonstop Service to New Orleans

OKLAHOMA CITY – Today United Airlines and their United Express partner, Trans States Airlines, launch nonstop service to New Orleans from Oklahoma City. The new service is the only nonstop flight between OKC and the Crescent City, saving Oklahoma City travelers time to one its top 25 destinations.



United has announced an introductory fare of \$99 one-way. Tickets must be purchased by February 27, 2006 and travel must be completed by March 31. Tickets can be purchased online at www.ual.com, through United Airlines reservations at 1-800-864-8331 or through travel agencies.

United Express will operate the new daily service seven days a week with 50-seat Embraer 145 regional jets. The schedule will be as follows:

Along with the New Orleans flight, United plans to add nonstop service to San Antonio in March. United Airlines also provides daily nonstop service from Will Rogers World Airport to Chicago and Denver.
