Will Rogers World Airport launches service to **eight** new destinations families love!

WILL ROGERS WORLD AIRPORT (**April 11, 2007**) – Just imagine sitting next to a three-year-old on your next flight to *Summer Vacation*. - May 7 San Diego (Think: World-famous San Diego Zoo! Legoland! Beaches!)

- June 7 Dulles International Airport (Think Washington D.C., national monuments AND easy connections to Europe and Asia!)

Southwest Airlines

- August 4 Baltimore Washington International (Think: Close to Washington D.C. and national monuments!)
