Airport Security Screener Receives Award from FAA

OKLAHOMA CITY - Checkpoint Security Supervisor Betty Dygert will be given the ***Screener of the Year Award for the Southwest Region*** Wednesday, October 14 at 9:30am in the VIP Room of Will Rogers World Airport.

The award is given annually by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to a checkpoint screener who has demonstrated excellence in his or her job. Criteria for the award include:

- * No failures on FAA checkpoint inspections
- * Effectiveness as a supervisor
- * Willingness to work with airlines
- * Perfect attendance record

Betty has been an employee of the Huntleigh Corporation for four years and has worked the entire time at Will Rogers. She was nominated for the award by the Huntleigh Security Manager, Debbie Andrews. "Being a security screener is a very difficult job," says Andrews. "Travelers are anxious to get to their gate and it can get a little harried at the checkpoints. Betty has always shown the utmost professionalism and done it with a smile."

Betty will now be eligible for the national title that will be announced in December. If she wins she will travel to Washington, D.C. to receive the award from the head of the FAA.
