## **NOW IS THE TIME TO APPLY ONLINE FOR TSA Pre✓<sup>®</sup> WRWA'S TEMPORARY ENROLLMENT CENTER OPENS NEXT WEEK**

OKLAHOMA CITY, August 16, 2016 – Oklahoma residents will have the opportunity to enroll in the Transportation Security Administration's popular expedited screening program, TSA Pre✓<sup>®</sup>, at the Will Rogers World Airport (WRWA) terminal beginning next Monday, August 22 through Friday, September 3. Starting the application process online and scheduling an appointment will save enrollees valuable time at the enrollment center.

"Applying online is easy," says Karen Carney, public information and marketing manager. "Doing so allows you to complete the required information and set an appointment that meets your schedule. By starting the process in advance, your time at the airport will generally take less than ten minutes."

The [TSA Pre✓<sup>®</sup>](#) program allows participating flyers to experience a more efficient airport screening process by leaving on their shoes, light jackets and belts and leaving laptops and compliant liquids in carry-on bags. Over 180 airports have dedicated TSA Pre✓<sup>®</sup> lanes and 16 airlines participate in the program.

To begin the application process, enrollees simply go to the [TSA Pre✓<sup>®</sup>](#) enrollment site. Complete steps one through seven, then at step eight, type in the location "Oklahoma City, OK" and choose "Will Rogers World Airport." Step 9 allows you to select an appointment time. The first available time always appears, but a different date and time can be selected by using the drop menu.

The application process is completed at the WRWA enrollment center where the applicant provides fingerprints, valid identity documentation and payment. The application fee is \$85 and can be paid by credit card, money order, company check, or certified/cashier's check. Cash and personal checks are not accepted. The application fee is valid for five (5) years. The center will accept walk-ups, but pre-application online is strongly encouraged.

The WRWA enrollment center will be located pre-security in the middle of the ticket lobby next to the American Airlines ticket counter, and will not require the applicant to be a ticketed passenger. *The center will be open Monday through Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. and Thursday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4 p.m.* The center will be closed Saturday and Sunday.

Once enrollment is complete, successful applicants will receive a Known Traveler Number (KTN) within a few weeks. The enrollee then enters that number when booking an airline reservation. The KTN can also be

added when booking reservations online via a participating airline website, via phone call to the airline reservation center or with a travel management company while making reservations. Additionally, the KTN can be entered in participating airline frequent flyer profiles, where it will be stored for future reservations.

Will Rogers World Airport is the city's commercial airport and accommodates over 3.8 million travelers each year. The airport serves 22 nonstop airports with an average of 69 daily departures.
